- 26 community meetings, at which about 1,100 people gave input.
- Online Survey (625 Completed Responses).
- Virtual Learning Journey, covering 70 "sites."
- 2 Physical Learning Journeys, covering 9 sites.

Methodology



The following "theme families" were drafted by Prospect Studio after analyzing some preliminary data that are emerging from Guiding Coalition 1 and early community meetings.

The phrases in the middle circle are meant to capture the broader essense of an emerging theme. The outer circles are a few persistent representative ideas generated from our broader community.

A constructivist approach is used to identify emerging theme areas. Individual inputs are grouped into affinity groups and those ideas that are persistent as well as innovative that relate to emerging theme areas are captured and examined.







- Physical environments that reimagine learning spaces and places for community




































































Early Emerging Themes
