Mr. Macon commented on the complaint process and expressed that he does not feel communicated with and that he does not feel that he was provided with sufficient assistance with the complaint process. Director Lowery shared that the District would need to address the process at another time and address the complaint at hand. Mr. Macon shared that all communication had been addressed to both Ms. Bensafia and the Macon Family, and as the father of the student at hand he would like to postpone the meeting until he receives the requested board resolutions and questions are answered. Ms. Large stated that the board could accommodate Mr. Macon's request as the complaint relates to his son. Chair Lowery stated they would adjourn the meeting in order to provide the requested information to Mr. Macon and reschedule another hearing to address Ms. Bensafia's complaint.
