Session Notes

- At the beginning of the session, the interpreters discussed the division of responsibilities
 which was extremely helpful. I was assigned to mainly help with the Cantonese
 speakers if needed.
- 2. All the parents expressed deep concern about the move from Woodstock. The main reasons were:
 - a. The Woodstock School has been doing the program for around 20 years and it has been highly successful.
 - b. Some parents that have children prepared to enter the Mandarin Immersion Program have purchased houses in that neighborhood for that purpose.
 - c. They were concerned that the proposed relocation would make their children more isolated and not gain the benefits of a more diverse neighborhood and culture.
 - d. There was also concerns about the transportation aspect of the move.
 - e. Also, there was dissatisfaction in that the school administration did not first communicate with native Chinese speaking families prior to the announcement of this proposed move.
- 3. Ms. Dai, the facilitator suggested that the parents attend the meeting in English this Thursday night.
- 4. Overall, it was very useful and informative meeting.
