**Subject**: LHS – CTE Program Addition Request for Audio Engineering

The Office of School Modernization is in construction for the Lincoln High School Modernization project. Lincoln High School is requesting changes to the project to accommodate their new CTE program for Audio Engineering. After completion of project design, the music teacher at Lincoln received CTE certification for Audio Engineering, along with grant funding and PPS CTE funding for equipment. The program started this current school year in a distance learning environment. The request is to have a physical classroom in the new building for the program. District CTE programming includes Audio Engineering for Lincoln. This program also exists at Wilson and Grant. Please see provided PPS CTE matrix.

Due to the size of individual student workstations, the standard general classroom size is too small to accommodate the program. The proposal is to combine two classrooms into one larger room to provide enough space for 30 workstations. This change will modify the school's area program by a reduction of 2 general education classrooms and an addition of one CTE classroom. The current area program provides 43 general education classrooms while the PPS Comprehensive HS Ed Specs require a minimum of 41 general education classrooms. This means that the reduction of 2 general education classrooms will still maintain the minimum Ed Spec requirement of 41. School capacity requirements will also still be met.

Changes to the building include additional construction costs of approximately \$160,000 for electrical, data, upgraded drop ceiling for acoustics, and a double stud wall at the adjacent classroom. An additional \$75,000 is estimated to provide a moveable partition, if desired. This is not required for the program but could provide future flexibility. A partition would require additional engineering and design. Additional FF&E costs are approximately \$100,000 but the team will work to cover this cost in the current overall FF&E budget of \$6,000,000.

Since the project is currently under construction, it is important to make a decision on the requested change as soon as possible to avoid construction delay and additional costs. The project team will be meeting with their Steering Committee shortly for discussion but OSM anticipates recommending moving forward with the requested changes, without adding the movable partition. Addition of the Audio Engineering CTE program to Lincoln is supported by school and District CTE staff, will not lower programming below Ed Specs requirements, and can be accommodated within the budget by utilizing standard risk mitigation strategies.
