



Foundation Policy

Director Greene shared what his approach to the work session on Foundation policies was and that he believes whatever decision is made is in the best interest of students. The proposal he shared was his attempt to continue with the School Improvement Grants that were being offered this year, while the district-wide fundraising model ramps up. He stated it would need to be vetted through the levy committee. Committee Chair Lowery stated that policy changes could not happen before the end of the year, and asked if the committee could put a pause on it and let the levy committee decide to refer it to the board.

Director Brim-Edwards offered there is hard work that would need to be done on how it is structured, including how to maintain an equitable funding formula. Chair Lowery asked that Director Brim-Edwards and Director Hollands work together on a detailed proposal to bring back to another meeting. She asked for a status report at the May Committee meeting.

Complaint Policy

The committee referred the amended complaint policy to the full board for a first reading at the May 23rd board meeting as proposed, with the removal of the word "may" in section "B".

Policies in the Public Comment Period

There have been no public comments received on the Community Use of Buildings and Facilities (CUB) 3.30.010-P Policy.

- Megan Mermis-She provided comments on the Foundation Policy. She stated frustration that the data that the advocacy group shared has not been used, and does not think the outreach is adequate. She believes there should be a district-wide foundation.
- Beth Cavanaugh-he provided comments on the Foundation Policy. Board members should answer what the problems are that we are trying to solve and wonder why there is a differentiated staffing model. Why does PPS have a differentiated staffing model?

Chair Lowery adjourned the meeting at 4:38 pm.
